**High risk pregnancies.** Even the healthiest pregnancies can encounter problems along the way or be complicated by premature birth, especially for



women who are over 35 years old or have known risk factors such as high blood pressure, lupus, diabetes, or other chronic diseases. Women carrying twins or more, or who delivered prematurely in the past, are also considered to be at high risk. Johns Hopkins obstetricians, perinatologists, anesthesiologists and neonatologists work together to deliver fully coordinated care for all high-risk pregnancies. Our hospital is one of only two Level IIIC Perinatal Units in the state, providing the highest level of care for mothers and babies.

**Fertility services.** One in six couples who wish to have children experience infertility problems. From diagnosis and counseling through fully coordinated treatment for both partners, Johns Hopkins offers a full range of assisted-reproduction alternatives to help couples achieve pregnancy.

## The Middle Age Years And Beyond

Many women assume that the onset of menopause means they no longer require regular gynecological exams. Nothing could be further from the truth. This is the time when changes

in hormonal levels and the aging process put women at greater risk for heart disease, osteoporosis and cancers of the reproductive system.

For many women, aging brings changes to the pelvic floor muscles causing leaky bladder syndrome and other forms of urinary incontinence. Johns Hopkins physicians specialize in diagnosing and treating these problems and returning women to an active and productive life.

## At Every Age

**Cancer screening and treatment.** Studies show time and time again that early detection and treatment is critical, whether for breast, cervical, uterine or ovarian cancer. Johns Hopkins gynecologists of the Kelly Gynecologic Oncology Service and the physicians of the Johns Hopkins Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center have pioneered many new treatments for these and other cancers. A wide variety of alternatives, including participation in clinical trials of new drugs and therapies, expands the treatment options available to Johns Hopkins cancer patients.
