



Johns Hopkins Birthing Center Driving and Parking Information

CHILDBIRTH:

We recommend that you use the Weinberg parking garage located on Jefferson Street, off Broadway (near Orleans Street, going north). On Jefferson Street make a right to get to the garage. After parking, look for the elevator sign and take to the lobby. Make two (2) lefts to the elevators that will take you to the main hospital, get off on the second floor. Make two (2) rights and one (1) left to get to the bridge to the hospital. From the bridge, proceed down the hall until you get to the end of the hall, make a right. Follow that hallway and look for the overhead sign that says, **Children's Medical and Service Center (CMSC)**. Take the elevators to the 9th floor. The class will be held in the **Garrett** Room. You may want to allow some extra time the first week if you are not familiar with the Johns Hopkins Hospital. We suggest that you wear comfortable clothing (usually slacks) as you will be doing exercises on the floor. Also, bring two bed-type pillows with you to each of the classes. Husbands and significant others are invited to classes also.

BREASTFEEDING: Follow the same directions as above but look for the overhead sign that says Halsted. Take the **Halsted** elevator to the second floor. Proceed left off elevator; **Halsted 201** is the second door on the right.
